The weather decided to make the 26.2 mile run even more difficult with record rain, high winds, and cold temperatures. The normal crowds lined the streets on a day that just being outside was miserable. Shortly after the start gun fired the surprises started happening and the elite runners of the world struggled with slower times and even a few potential winners dropped from the race. Elite runner Shalane Flanagan said her body switched from thriving to surviving around mile 16 and she had to refocus her thoughts to just finishing being the challenge.

Then along came a runner from our group. WCRRC of southwestern PA, full of heart and determination pushing through the unfamiliar course. As she topped heartbreak hill she had to ask a spectator, "Was that heartbreak?". When she heard yes, she answered with a confident. "Oh I got this!" She continued her strong pace and cruised down Boylston street absorbing all of the sights and cheers from the crowd. She crossed the finish line at 3:40:07 recording new PR and BQ times and proving without any doubt that with hard work, grit, and determinationimpossible is nothing. For all who witnessed the day, they walked away full of inspiration. motivation, and admiration. Congratulations Amy Koontz! Amazing run! We are proud of you and this accomplishment! You earned your spot in the Boston Marathon history and tradition.


